



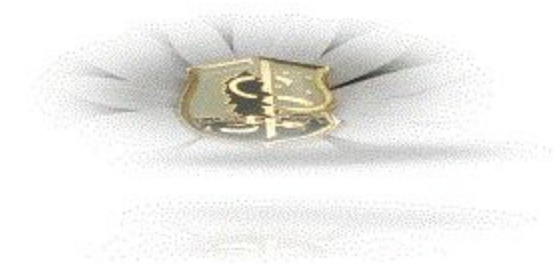
Kia Ora Parents and Whānau,

This message is to inform you that school starts back for all students and staff on Monday 31 August. We are looking forward to warmly welcoming your children to school and settling them back into a safe, healthy and happy school environment. In order to do this in a positive and safe manner there are firm protocols which need to be followed by us all. Please help us, and your children, by reading and following these guidelines - many thanks for your support with this:

1. Parents to stay outside the school gates for this period. We will maintain the practice of students only coming to class in the mornings with parents saying “Goodbye” at the gates and meeting students at the gates in the afternoon. Students will be met by non classroom based staff at both school gates and directed to class where teachers will be in their rooms from 8.30am. Families who may need more support, please contact Associate Principal, Anne-Maree Beveridge, to discuss your concerns.
2. New families to the school and Rm 20 this term need to arrive at 8.45am. They will be met at the Kinsale Ave gate, contact register signed or QR code scanned and accompanied to class.
3. *Years 1 and 2 children will finish school at 2.45pm* so parents need to be available to pick them up at both school gates then (siblings will join them at this time).

Rooms 18, 19 and 20 children will be released at 2.40pm.

4. All children need to bring a filled water bottle as the water fountains will be off.
5. Playground equipment can be used during school time, as per MOE and Sport NZ guidelines, with the use of hand sanitiser before and after.
6. OSCAR programmes will begin on Monday 31 August for before and after school care.
7. Current distance learning programmes will be coming to an end by Friday 28 August. The last Class Korero on Friday will be a “Welcome Back to Churchill Park School” message.
8. Recommended hygiene practices to be followed at all times including:
 - Frequent use of hand washing and sanitiser



- Cough / sneeze into your elbow
- No touching, keeping out of breathing distance
- Students / staff to stay home if showing signs of illness
