

Churchill Park School at Red (Parents)

Schools and kura are open for onsite learning for all students

- **Hygiene measures will be in place**
 - Regular handwashing
 - Cough and sneeze etiquette in place
 - Cleaning of surfaces
 - Mask wearing is mandated for students (Years 4 and up)
 - Mask wearing is mandated for all staff (Years 4 and up)
 - Spaces will be well ventilated: doors and windows open, air-con on
 - All students should closely monitor for symptoms, stay home if unwell, and get tested if symptomatic - communicate this with the school please (Roz or Jenny in the office)
 - Attendance is encouraged for all students
 - Absentee notification is essential
 - Designated playground areas for syndicates
 - Drinking fountains are not to be used. Provide water bottles. Reusable cups will be purchased, available at the office - please name

- **Sports Uniforms can be worn at all times to avoid the need to change**

- **A class is considered a cohort**
 - Mixing of students is confined to a class
 - No full school assemblies or syndicate assemblies

- **Visitors on-site**
 - External providers onsite who work with students (paid and unpaid) must be vaccinated, scan in, and wear masks
 - All visitors on-site must scan in and wear masks. If coming onto grounds for other purposes, vaccine passes are to be shown at the office
 - Parents are asked to drop off and pick up at gates
 - Gate duties apply morning and afternoon
 - Staggered pickups in the afternoon
 - Year 1: 2:45 p.m.
 - Year 2: 2:50 p.m.
 - Designated entry-exit gates for Kinsale Avenue
 - Years 1-4: Main entrance
 - Years 5-8: Hall entrance

- **Sporting events / EOTC / large gatherings**
 - Swimtastic lessons can go ahead - students to wear masks
 - Swimming sports - not at this stage
 - Parent helpers and spectators need to be vaccinated
 - Camp Kari is postponed
 - No Inter-School activities at this point
 - Top Schools will probably not go ahead - more clarification required
