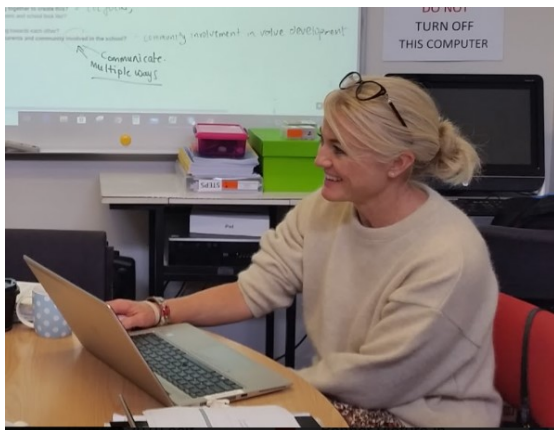


Ara continues to facilitate our professional development across the schools, developing our Wellbeing frameworks.
